Datablitz and Poster instructions

Language

The official language of oral and poster presentations is English.

Poster

Posters should be made to fit **A0 size (length 119 cm x width 84 cm)**. Your poster should be readable from a 2-meter distance; as a rough guideline, use a font size of 72 pts for your title, and a minimum of 28 pts for your text. Posters can be mounted in the morning or during lunch and should be removed at the end of the session (see program).

Abstracts

All presenters (including poster presenters) are requested to submit an abstract (in MS Word-format) for publication in the program booklet to e.a.vanvliet@uva.nl Layout of the abstracts should be as follows: title, authors, affiliations, abstract (not exceeding 300 words) and the presenters name, phone and email. The abstract should state briefly the aim of the research, methods, the principal results and major conclusions (see following example).

Deadline for submission of the abstract is 31 January 2023.

Datablitz

Each junior participant of the poster session is expected to prepare a short, **maximum 2.5 minutes**, power point presentation of the poster, which can be presented during the datablitz session (see program). The blitz presentation will proceed in the order noted in the program and the poster presentation is scheduled later on the day. You are kindly requested to send your blitz presentation to e.a.vanvliet@uva.nl Presentations will be given on a laptop with Windows. Participants who created their presentation on an Apple/MAC computer should check their entire presentation in advance on the laptop to be sure that all animations and images appear as intended. **Deadline for submission of the datablitz presentation is 20 March 2023.**
